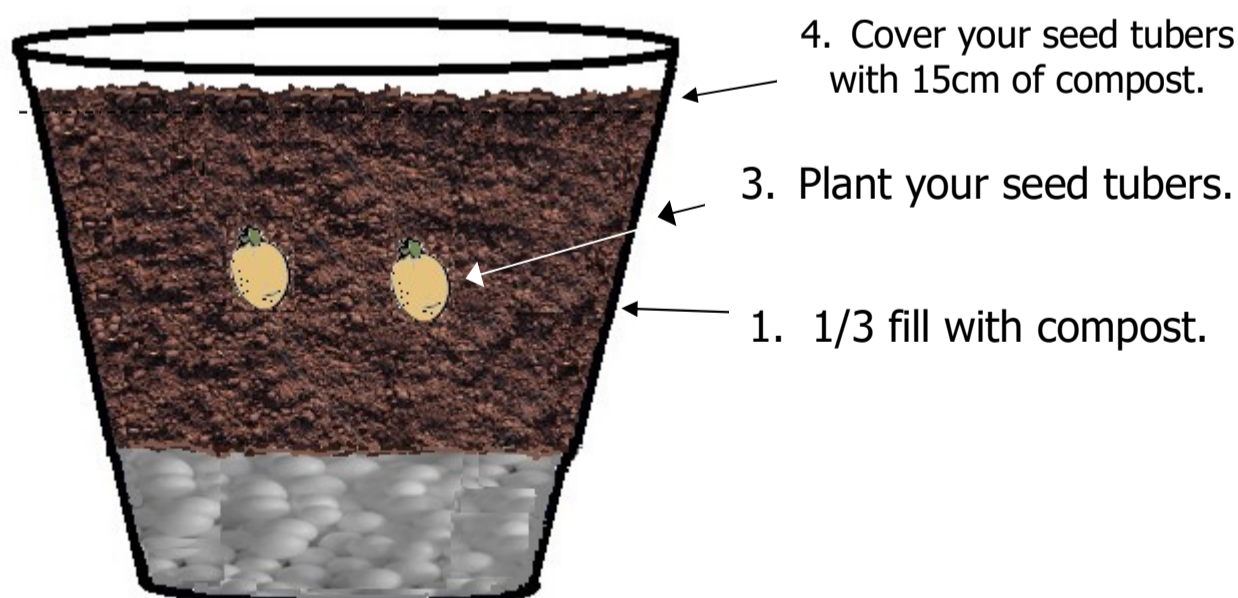




Planting Guide

Participants will be supplied with: A container, Compost, Fertiliser and two Jersey Royal seed potatoes.

1. Fill the container 1/3 full of compost and mix in the fertiliser.
2. Tap the bucket on the floor to settle the compost and leave a flat surface.
3. Plant the two seed tubers evenly in the bucket. Each tuber should be approximately 7 cm from the side of the bucket and placed on the surface of the compost so that the length of the tuber lies on the compost but at a slight angle so the shoots are tilted upwards.
4. Cover the tubers with approximately 15cm of compost.
5. Water in your potatoes until the water drains out of the drainage holes in the bottom of the bucket.
6. Place your bucket in a light, sheltered spot.
7. Keep the compost damp but do not over water. The bigger your potato plants grow the more water they may need.
